**“High Priest” (Hebrew “gadowl kohan” Greek “archiereus”)**

**The “high priest” is different than a “priest,” (Lev. 21:10).**

**“A high priest is appointed for men in the things pertaining to God,” (Heb. 2:17; 5:1).**

<b>(Priesthood)</b>	<b>Kingship(1:8) Priesthood (5:5)</b>
<b>(Levi, Num. 16:5-8)</b>	<b>Melchizedek (5:6,9)</b>
<b>Offer gifts and sacrifices for sins (5:1,3)</b>	<b>New eternal order of salvation (5:9)</b>
<b>(high priest, Lev. 21:10-16)</b>	<b>A “great” high priest (4:14)</b>
